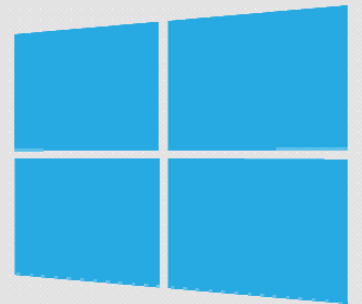

- Custom Data
 - Error Reporting
 - Application logging

- Dedicated SDK for Windows 8.1 Applications
- Properties
 - Location
 - Zoom level
 - Map type
 - Adding Pushpins
- Interacting with the map control
 - Overlaying images
 - Moving the map
 - Zooming in / out

- Designed specifically for Windows 8/Windows 8.1
- Part of Visual Studio 2013
- Multiple ad sizes
- Directly linked to your Windows Developer account
- Automatic payouts
